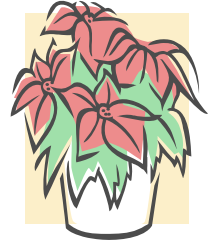

Green Report...Gino Marchetti, Superintendent

We are now coming to an end of the 2020 season and there are many things that need to be completed in preparation for winter. This includes potassium and gypsum applications to the greens. Potassium helps to build carbohydrate reserves in the plant for use throughout the winter months and gypsum helps to flush bicarbonates out of the soils. We are also going to be topdressing weekly and discontinue mowing greens, the taller the greens the more room for storage. The topdressing will create a thick layer of sand that will protect the crowns of the turf throughout the winter months.

Covers will be installed on the greens when the turf has hardened off for the year, the ground is not completely frozen and there is a significant snow forecasted. This should be sometime in December. This information will be posted through Clubster.

Just a reminder to continue to fill or replace your divots on fairways doing winter play. This will allow us to get a good start to the 2021 season. There will also be times that the course will be closed do to freezing temperatures. Information will be sent to you through the Pro Shop.
